VI Place of the King's Chief Secretary.

And that the Kinges Chief Secretary beinge of the degre of a Baron of the Parliament shall sytt and be placed afore and above all Baronys, not havinge eny of the offices aforemencioned; And if he be a Bisshope, that then he shall sytt and be placed above all other Bisshopps, not havinge any of the offices above remembred.
