## ANNUAL REPORTS BY OTHER PUBLIC BODIES

## Public bodies: general

- 1 (1) A public body (other than the Welsh Ministers or one mentioned in subparagraph (3)) must publish, in respect of each financial year, a report of the progress it has made in meeting its well-being objectives.
  - (2) A report under this paragraph must be published as soon as reasonably practicable following the end of the financial year to which the report relates.
  - (3) This paragraph does not apply to—
    - (a) a Local Health Board or NHS trust (as to which, see paragraph 2);
    - (b) the Natural Resources Body for Wales (as to which, see paragraph 3).

## Local Health Boards and NHS trusts
