CHAPTER 4

INSPECTIONS OF PREMISES AND OTHER PROPERTY

107 Producing authorisation to carry out inspections

If a person carrying out an inspection under section 103 $[^{FI}$, 103A, 103B] or 106 is unable to produce evidence of authority to carry out the inspection when asked to do so by—

- (a) the occupier of the premises, or
- (b) any other person who appears to be in charge of, or to control, the premises, the inspection must stop and may not be continued until such evidence is produced.
