SECOND SCHEDULE

PROCEDURE FOR MAKING ORDERS, &C.

- 2 Every objection must be in writing and state—
- (a) the draft order or portions of the draft order objected to;
 - (b) the specific grounds of objection; and
 - (c) the omissions, additions, or modifications asked for.
