### GENERAL AND MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS RELATING TO PARTS 1 TO 3

#### **30**      **Modification of enactments etc.**

- (1) Ministers may, by order, make such modification as they consider necessary or expedient of any enactment or instrument governing the conduct of a councillor or a member of a devolved public body <sup>F1</sup> . . . or the tenure of office, suspension, removal from office, disqualification or discipline of any such person in order to make that enactment or instrument consistent with this Act and with the provisions of any code under it applicable to that person.
- (2) An order under subsection (1) above shall be made by statutory instrument.
- (3) No such order shall be made unless a draft of the statutory instrument has been laid before, and approved by a resolution of, the Scottish Parliament.
