### PART 1

#### THE COMMISSION AND CARE SERVICES

##### *Proposals and applications in relation to registered care services*

#### **19 Conditions as to numbers**

Without prejudice to the generality of section 9(1), 13(1) or 18(1)(c) of this Act, a condition imposed under any of those provisions in relation to a care service may limit—

- (a) in the case of—
  - (i) a care home service;
  - (ii) a school care accommodation service; or
  - (iii) a secure accommodation service,the number of persons for whom the service may provide accommodation;
- (b) in the case of an adult placement service, the number of persons whom the service may place;
- (c) in the case of—
  - (i) a support service; or
  - (ii) an independent health care service,the number of persons to whom the service may be provided;
- (d) in the case of—
  - (i) child minding; or
  - (ii) day care of children,the number of children for whom a person may act as a child minder or for whom day care may be provided; and
- (e) in the case of a nurse agency, the number of persons for whom the agency may supply registered nurses, registered midwives or registered health visitors.
