Investigations by the Ombudsman

Section 3 and schedule 2 – Persons liable to investigation

- 20. This section and *schedule* 2set out which persons, or classes of persons, are liable to investigation by the Ombudsman (throughout the Act referred to as *listed authorities*) and provide for amendments to be made to Part 2 of that list of persons.
- 21. *Subsection (1)* provides that the persons, or classes of persons, listed in Parts 1 and 2 of schedule 2 are liable to investigation by the Ombudsman.
- 22. Subsections (2) to (6)provide for Her Majesty, by Order in Council, to amend Part 2 of the schedule by adding, removing or modifying entries, subject to certain restrictions. Additions to the schedule may only be made if the entry relates to a Scottish public authority with mixed functions or no reserved functions; a publicly-owned company; or a person who is neither a Scottish public authority nor a publicly-owned company but who appears to Her Majesty to exercise functions of a public nature. A person who is neither a Scottish public authority nor a publicly-owned company but who appears to Her Majesty to exercise functions of a public nature. A person who is neither a Scottish public authority nor a publicly-owned company must be consulted before being added to Part 2 of the schedule.
