#### REVIEW OF COMPULSION ORDERS

#### *Powers of Tribunal*

#### **173 Applications to Tribunal: ancillary powers**

- (1) This section applies where—
  - (a) an application is made to the Tribunal under section 149, 158, 161, 163 or 164 of this Act; or
  - (b) the Tribunal is, under section 165 of this Act, reviewing a determination.
- (2) Regulations may prescribe circumstances in which the Tribunal may require—
  - (a) the patient's responsible medical officer; or
  - (b) the mental health officer,to prepare and submit to the Tribunal reports on such matters as may be prescribed.
