Section 5: Compliance with guidance documents

As the documents referred to in section 4 have the status of guidance, they will not provide the sole means of meeting the requirements of building regulations. *Subsections* (1) and (2) clarify that failure to comply with guidance documents does not in itself render a person liable to civil or criminal proceedings, though proof of compliance with them may be relied on in any proceedings as evidence that building regulations have not been contravened. *Subsection* (3) provides that notices issuing, revising or withdrawing guidance, and documents appearing to be guidance documents, are to be accepted as such during any legal proceedings unless the contrary is proved.
