

## Licensing (Scotland) Act 2005

## PART 1

## **CORE PROVISIONS**

## 1 Prohibition of unlicensed sale of alcohol

- (1) Alcohol is not to be sold on any premises except under and in accordance with—
  - (a) a premises licence, or
  - (b) an occasional licence,

granted under this Act in respect of the premises.

- (2) Subsection (1) does not apply to the selling of alcohol—
  - (a) on exempt premises, or
  - (b) to trade.
- (3) A person who—
  - (a) sells alcohol, or
  - (b) knowingly allows alcohol to be sold,

in breach of subsection (1) commits an offence.

- (4) A person guilty of an offence under subsection (3) is liable on summary conviction to—
  - (a) a fine not exceeding £20,000,
  - (b) imprisonment for a term not exceeding 6 months, or
  - (c) both.
