OFFENCES

Offences relating to children and young people

Allowing the sale of alcohol to a child or young person

- (1) Any responsible person who F1... allows alcohol to be sold to a child or a young person on any relevant premises commits an offence.
- (2) A person guilty of an offence under subsection (1) is liable on summary conviction to—
 - (a) a fine not exceeding level 5 on the standard scale,
 - (b) imprisonment for a term not exceeding 3 months, or
 - (c) both.
