### Supplementary

#### 51 Prohibition on employment of police

[<sup>F2</sup>SFRS] may not employ a constable [<sup>F3</sup>(other than a special constable appointed under section 9 of the Police and Fire Reform (Scotland) Act 2012 (asp 8))] for the purpose of carrying out any of the functions conferred on [<sup>F4</sup>it] by virtue of this Act.
