Interpretation

- 18 In this schedule, a “relevant power” is a power—
- (a) conferred on an inspector by—
 - (i) a provision of this schedule, or
 - (ii) a warrant granted under a provision of this schedule,
 - (b) conferred on a constable by—
 - (i) a provision of this schedule ^{F1}..., or
 - (ii) a warrant granted under a provision of this schedule.
