## PLANNING ETC. (SCOTLAND) ACT 2006

## **EXPLANATORY NOTES**

## **BACKGROUND**

- 3. The Act will provide a mechanism for the delivery of a modernised planning system, as set out in the Policy Memorandum to the Bill. It takes forward the commitment in *A Partnership for a Better Scotland* to improve the planning system to strengthen involvement of communities, speed up decisions, reflect local views better and allow quicker investment decisions.
- 4. The package set out in the White Paper *Modernising the Planning System*, published in June 2005, brought together the Scottish Executive's final proposals for modernisation of the system in a single document. The Paper identifies elements of the modernisation package that require changes to primary legislation, secondary legislation, and elements that can be dealt with through guidance.
- 5. The purpose of the Act is to amend existing planning legislation to implement the proposals in the White Paper, *Modernising the Planning System*, which require changes to primary legislation. It also introduces provisions to implement Business Improvement Districts in Scotland, as set out in *A Partnership for a Better Scotland*.
