PROTECTION OF ADULTS AT RISK OF HARM

Banning orders

25 Powers of arrest

(1) The sheriff may attach a power of arrest to any—

- (a) banning order, or
- (b) temporary banning order.
- (2) Any such power of arrest—
 - (a) becomes effective when it is served (together with such documents as may be prescribed) on the subject of the order, and
 - (b) expires together with the order to which it is attached.
