Adult Protection Committees

44 Committee procedure

- (1) It is for an Adult Protection Committee to regulate its own procedures.
- (2) But those procedures must allow a representative of—
 - (a) the Mental Welfare Commission for Scotland,
 - (b) the Public Guardian,
 - (c) [F1SCSWIS] (where it has not nominated a representative to be a member of the Committee), and
 - (d) any other public body or office-holder as the Scottish Ministers may by order specify,to attend Committee meetings.
