- 3 In the Sea Fish (Conservation) Act 1967—
- (a) in section 4 (licensing of fishing boats), subsections (9A) and (9B) are repealed,
  - (b) in section 11 (penalties for offences)—
    - (i) in subsection (1)(b), “, 4(9A)” is repealed,
    - (ii) in subsection (2), for “, (6) and (9A)” substitute “and (6)”,
    - (iii) in subsection (2)(c), for “, (6) or (9A)” substitute “or (6)”,
    - (iv) in subsection (2)(d), for “, (6) or (9A)” substitute “or (6)”,
    - (v) in subsection (3), for “, (6) or (9A)” substitute “or (6)”,
  - (c) in section 15(2)(b) (powers of British sea-fishery officers), for “, (6) or (9A)” substitute “or (6)”.
