

Abolition of Bridge Tolls (Scotland) Act 2008

Miscellaneous and general

3 Minor and consequential amendments and repeals

- (1) Schedule 1, which contains minor amendments and amendments consequential on the provisions of this Act, has effect.
- (2) The enactments mentioned in the first column of Part 1 of schedule 2 (which are enactments already obsolete or unnecessary) are repealed to the extent specified in the second column of that Part.
- (3) The enactments mentioned in the first column of Part 2 of schedule 2 (which include enactments already obsolete or unnecessary) are revoked to the extent specified in the second column of that Part.

4 Short title and commencement

- (1) This Act may be cited as the Abolition of Bridge Tolls (Scotland) Act 2008.
- (2) The provisions of this Act, except this section, come into force on such day as the Scottish Ministers may by order made by statutory instrument appoint.
