AMENDMENTS RELATING TO PART 1

Public Services Reform (Scotland) Act 2010 (asp 8)

- 40 (1) The Public Services Reform (Scotland) Act 2010 is amended as follows.
- (2) In section 114 (scrutiny: duty of co-operation)—
- (a) in subsection (2)—
 - (i) the word “and” at the end of paragraph (b) is repealed,
 - (ii) after paragraph (c) insert “, and
 - (d) policing.”,
 - (b) in subsection (3)(a)—
 - (i) the word “or” at the end of sub-paragraph (ii) is repealed,
 - (ii) after sub-paragraph (iii) insert—
 - “(iv) policing, or”,
 - (c) in subsection (10)(b)—
 - (i) for “or health services” substitute “, health services or policing ”,
 - (ii) after “services”, where last occurring, insert “ or, as the case may be, policing ”,
 - (d) in subsection (11), after the definition of “local authorities” insert—
 - ““policing” has the same meaning as in Part 1 of the Police and Fire Reform (Scotland) Act 2012;”.
- (3) In section 115(6) (joint inspections), for the entry beginning “Her Majesty's Chief Inspector of Constabulary”, substitute— “ Her Majesty's Inspectors of Constabulary appointed under section 71 of the Police and Fire Reform (Scotland) Act 2012 (asp 8), ”.
- (4) In schedule 5 (improvement of public functions: listed bodies), for the entry for “Police Complaints Commissioner for Scotland” substitute— “ Police Investigations and Review Commissioner ”.
- (5) In schedule 8 (information on exercise of public functions: listed public bodies), for the entry for “Police Complaints Commissioner for Scotland” substitute— “ Police Investigations and Review Commissioner ”.
- (6) In schedule 19 (scrutiny functions: persons etc. subject to user focus duty), for the entry beginning “Her Majesty's Chief Inspector of Constabulary”, substitute— “ Her Majesty's Inspectors of Constabulary appointed under section 71 of the Police and Fire Reform (Scotland) Act 2012 (asp 8) ”.
- (7) In schedule 20 (scrutiny functions: persons etc. subject to duty of co-operation), for the entry beginning “Her Majesty's Chief Inspector of Constabulary”, substitute— “ Her Majesty's Inspectors of Constabulary appointed under section 71 of the Police and Fire Reform (Scotland) Act 2012 (asp 8) ”.
