**Policing (Miscellaneous Provisions) (Northern Ireland)  
Order 2007 (Commencement No. 1) Order 2013**

*Made - - - - 13th March 2013*

The Department of Justice makes the following Order, in exercise of the powers conferred by article 1(2)(b) of the Policing (Miscellaneous Provisions) (Northern Ireland) Order 2007(1), and now vested in it(2).

**Citation**

1. This Order may be cited as the Policing (Miscellaneous Provisions) (Northern Ireland) Order 2007 (Commencement No. 1) Order 2013.

**Commencement**

2. The day appointed for the coming into operation of article 12 of the Policing (Miscellaneous Provisions) (Northern Ireland) Order 2007 is 25th March 2013.
