**PLANT HEALTH**

**The Plant Health Fees (Scotland) Amendment Regulations 2005**

*Made* - - - - 8th November 2005  
*Laid before the Scottish*  
*Parliament* - - - - 9th November 2005  
*Coming into force* - - 5th December 2005

The Scottish Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 2(2) of the European Communities Act 1972<sup>(1)</sup> and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following Regulations:

**Citation and commencement**

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Plant Health Fees (Scotland) Amendment Regulations 2005 and shall come into force on 5th December 2005.

**Amendment to the Plant Health Fees (Scotland) Regulations 1996**

2. For Schedule 2 (fees in respect of licensing services) to the Plant Health Fees (Scotland) Regulations 1996<sup>(2)</sup> substitute Schedule 2 as contained in the Schedule to these Regulations.

## **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*(This note is not part of the Regulations)*

These Regulations, which come into force on 5th December 2005, increase certain fees in respect of licensing services chargeable under regulation 4 and Schedule 2 to the Plant Health Fees (Scotland) Regulations 1996 (regulation 2).
