1968 CHAPTER 29

Miscellaneous and supplemental.

39 Interpretation.

- (1) The following provisions shall have effect, in addition to sections [F1 2 to 4] of this Act, for the interpretation in this Act of expressions used therein, that is to say,—
- “advertisement” includes a catalogue, a circular and a price list;
 - “goods” includes ships and aircraft, things attached to land and growing crops;
 - “premises” includes any place and any stall, vehicle, ship or aircraft; and
 - “ship” includes any boat and any other description of vessel used in navigation.
