PROCEEDINGS IN UNITED KINGDOM BY OR AGAINST OTHER STATES

Exceptions from immunity

5 Personal injuries and damage to property.

A State is not immune as respects proceedings in respect of—

- (a) death or personal injury; or
- (b) damage to or loss of tangible property, caused by an act or omission in the United Kingdom.
