##### *Grounds for invalidity of registration*

- 14 Apart from the grounds of invalidity provided for in section 47, the registration of a collective mark [<sup>F1</sup>shall] be declared invalid on the ground that the mark was registered in breach of the provisions of [<sup>F2</sup>section 49(1A) (definition of who may be registered as the proprietor of a certification mark) or] paragraph 4(1) or 6(1) [<sup>F3</sup>unless the breach was only of paragraph 6(1) and the proprietor of the mark, by amending the regulations governing use, complies with the requirements of paragraph 6(1)].
