

# Law Officers Act 1997

### **1997 CHAPTER 60**

## 2 The Attorney General for Northern Ireland and the Solicitor General.

- (1) Any function of the [FIAdvocate General for Northern Ireland] may be exercised by the Solicitor General for England and Wales.
- (2) Anything done by or in relation to the Solicitor General in the exercise of or in connection with a function of the [F2Advocate General] has effect as if done by or in relation to the [F2Advocate General].
- (3) The validity of anything done in relation to the [F2Advocate General], or done by or in relation to the Solicitor General, is not affected by a vacancy in the office of [F2Advocate General].
- (4) Nothing in this section—
  - (a) prevents anything being done by or in relation to the [F2Advocate General] in the exercise of or in connection with any function of his; or
  - (b) requires anything done by the Solicitor General to be done in the name of the Solicitor General instead of the name of the [F2Advocate General].
- (5) It is immaterial for the purposes of this section whether a function of the [F2Advocate General] arises under an enactment or otherwise.
- (6) In this section [F3":Advocate General" means the Advocate] General for Northern Ireland.
