#### 104 Evidence of wages of defendant.

In any proceedings under this Act a copy of an entry in the wages book of any employer of labour, or if no wages book be kept a written statement signed by the employer or by any responsible person in his employ, shall be evidence that the wages therein entered or stated as having been paid to any person, have in fact been so paid.

#### 105 Summary jurisdiction.

- (1) Subject to the provisions of this Act, all orders of a court of summary jurisdiction under this Act shall be made, and all proceedings in relation to any such orders shall be taken, in manner [F13 provided by the M2 Criminal Procedure (Scotland) Act 1975].
- (2) Any magistrate who, by virtue of a local Act had jurisdiction before the first day of April nineteen hundred and nine for any of the purposes of the M³Prevention of Cruelty to Children Act 1904, shall have jurisdiction for the like purposes of Part II of this Act.

(	1) In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them, that is say:—
	"Borstal institution" means an institution established under [F21 section 31 of the M4Prisons (Scotland) Act 1952];
	"Child" (except [F23 in [F24Parts III and IV]] of this Act) means a person under the age of fourteen years;
	"Court of summary jurisdiction" means the sheriff or any two or more justices of the peace or any magistrate or magistrates by whatever name called officiating under the provisions of any general or local police Act; "Guardian," in relation to a child or young person, includes any person who, in the opinion of the court having cognizance of any case in relation to the child or young person or in which the child or young person is concerned, has for the time being the charge of or control over the child or young person;
	"Justice" <sup>F27</sup> includes the sheriff and any such magistrate as aforesaid;

"Legal guardian" in relation to a child or young person means a person appointed according to law, to be his guardian by deed or will, or by order of a court or competent jurisdiction;
