

## Parks Regulation Act 1872

1872 CHAPTER 15 35 and 36 Vict

## 7 Powers, duties, and privileges of park-keeper.

Every [<sup>F1</sup>park constable] in addition to any powers and immunities specially conferred on him by this Act, shall, within the limits of the park of which he is [<sup>F1</sup>park constable], have all such powers, privileges, and immunities, and be liable to all such duties and responsibilities, as any police constable has within the [<sup>F2</sup>police area] in which such park is situated; and any person so appointed a [<sup>F1</sup>park constable] as aforesaid shall obey such lawful commands as he may from time to time receive from [<sup>F3</sup>the Secretary of State] in respect of his conduct in the execution of his office.
