HOUSING, ENGLAND AND WALES

The Housing (Welfare Services) (Wales) Order 1995

Made - - - - *9th October 1995*

The Secretary of State for Wales, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 128 of the Leasehold Reform, Housing and Urban Development Act 1993⁽¹⁾ and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:—

Citation and application

- 1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Housing (Welfare Services) (Wales) Order 1995.
- (2) This Order shall apply to local housing authorities in Wales only.

Excluded services

2. In respect of any year beginning on or after 1st April 1996 the provisions made by section 127 of the Leasehold Reform, Housing and Urban Development Act 1993 (accounting for housing welfare services) shall cease to apply in respect of the services described in the Schedule to this Order.
