Citation

1. This Order may be cited as the Climate Change and Sustainable Energy Act 2006 (Commencement) Order 2007.

Provisions coming into force

2. Sections 15 to 17 of the Climate Change and Sustainable Energy Act 2006 Act shall come into force on 28th February 2007.
