Interpretation

3 In this Schedule—

“public authority” (“awdurdod cyhoeddus”) means each public authority within the meaning of section 6 of the Human Rights Act 1998;

“public money” (“arian cyhoeddus”) means—

(a) moneys made available directly or indirectly by—

(i) the National Assembly for Wales;

(ii) the Welsh Ministers;

(iii) Parliament;

(iv) Ministers of the Crown; ^{F1}...

(v) ^{F1}...

(b) moneys provided by virtue of any enactment.
