CHAPTER V

RECOGNITION AND EFFECTS OF THE ADOPTION

Article 25

Any Contracting State may declare to the depositary of the convention that it will not be bound under this Convention to recognise adoptions made in accordance with an agreement concluded by application of Article 39, paragraph 2. Changes to legislation:
