The Commissioner

The Commissioner for Older People for Northern Ireland

- **1.**—(1) There is to be an officer known as the Commissioner for Older People for Northern Ireland.
- (2) The Commissioner is to be appointed by the First Minister and deputy First Minister acting jointly.
- (3) The appointment of the Commissioner under subsection (2) may be made only after taking account of the views of persons aged 60 or over in accordance with arrangements made by [F1 the Executive Office].
 - (4) Schedule 1 has effect in relation to the Commissioner.
