**The Probation Board (Northern Ireland) Order 1982**

*Introductory*

***Interpretation***

**2.—**(1) The Interpretation Act (Northern Ireland) 1954<sup>F1</sup> shall apply to Article 1 and the following provisions of this Order as it applies to a Measure of the Northern Ireland Assembly.

(2) In this Order—

“bail hostel” means premises for the accommodation of persons remanded on bail;

“the Board” means the Probation Board for Northern Ireland;

[<sup>F2</sup>“community service order” means an order under Article 13 of the Criminal Justice (Northern Ireland) Order 1996]

“member of the staff of the Board” includes probation officer;

“prescribed” means prescribed by regulations made by the [<sup>F3</sup>Department of Justice];

“probation hostel” means premises for the reception and care of persons who may be required to reside there by a probation order;

“probation order” means an order under [<sup>F2</sup> Article 10 of the Criminal Justice (Northern Ireland) Order 1996]

“statutory provision” has the meaning assigned to it by section 1 (*f*) of the Interpretation Act (Northern Ireland) 1954;

“young offenders centre” has the meaning assigned to it by section 2 (*a*) of the Treatment of Offenders Act (Northern Ireland) 1968<sup>F4</sup>.
