Abolition of felling licences

20. Sections 4 to 8 of the Forestry Act (Northern Ireland) 1953^{F3} (which require a person felling certain growing trees to hold a felling licence) shall cease to have effect.

Licensing of slaughter-houses

21. In section 1 of the Slaughter-houses Act (Northern Ireland) 1953^{F4} (licensing of slaughter-houses) subsection (4)(f) (which empowers the Department to refuse a licence if not satisfied that the premises are needed for use as a slaughter-house) shall cease to have effect.

22. The Control of Fertilisers Act (Northern Ireland) Act 1953^{F5} (which provides for fertilisers to be sold only by licensed persons) shall cease to have effect.
