Reviews and appeals

Appeal to Social Security Commissioner

- **15.**—(1) An appeal may be made to a Commissioner against any decision of a medical appeal tribunal under Article 14 on the ground that the decision was erroneous in point of law.
 - (2) An appeal under this Article may be made by—
 - (a) the Department,
 - (b) the person who applied for the certificate of recoverable benefits, F2 or
 - ^{F3}(c) (in a case where the amount of the compensation payment has been calculated in accordance with Article 10[^{F4}or 10A]) the injured person or other person to whom the payment is made,

[F5but the scheme administrator of the Diffuse Mesothelioma Payment Scheme may not appeal under this Article.]

- (4) In this Article "Commissioner" has the same meaning as in section 167(1) of the Administration Act.
