The Departments (Northern Ireland) Order 1999

Evidence of acts of department

- 7.—(1) Every document purporting to be issued by a department and—
 - (a) to be sealed with the seal of the department authenticated as provided by Article 6(2); or
 - (b) to be signed by the Minister or a senior officer of the department or other officer of the department authorised by the Minister in that behalf,

shall be received in evidence and be deemed to be such a document without further proof, unless the contrary is shown.

- (2) A certificate signed by—
 - (a) the Minister; or
 - (b) a senior officer of a department,

that a document purporting to be issued by the department is so issued shall be conclusive evidence of the facts so certified.

- (3) The Documentary Evidence Act 1868, as amended by the Documentary Evidence Act 1882, shall apply to a department as if—
 - (a) the department were mentioned in the first column of the Schedule to the Act of 1868 and the Minister or a senior officer of the department were mentioned in the second column of that Schedule;
 - (b) the regulations referred to in those Acts included any document issued by the department.
