INDUSTRIAL AND PROVIDENT SOCIETIES**Payment for Copies of Rules**

REGULATIONS, DATED 13TH DECEMBER 1974, MADE BY THE REGISTRAR OF FRIENDLY SOCIETIES UNDER SECTIONS 14(1) AND 97(3) OF THE INDUSTRIAL AND PROVIDENT SOCIETIES ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1969.

The Registrar, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by sections 14(1) and 97(3) of the Industrial and Provident Societies Act (Northern Ireland) 1969(a) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations:

1. These regulations may be cited as the Industrial and Provident Societies (Payment for Copies of Rules) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1974 and shall come into operation on 1st February 1975.

2. A sum not exceeding 50 pence is hereby prescribed as the sum which a registered society may charge for a copy of its rules delivered under section 14 of the Industrial and Provident Societies Act (Northern Ireland) 1969.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

These regulations increase the maximum sum a society may charge for a copy of its rules from 10 pence to 50 pence.
