## The Judicial Pensions (Northern Ireland) (Widows' and Children's Benefits) (Amendment) Regulations 1987

To be laid before Parliament

Regulations dated 27th March 1987 made by the Lord Chancellor under the Administration of Justice Act 1973

The Lord Chancellor, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 10(8) of and Schedule 3 to the Administration of Justice Act 1973(a) and now vested in him by Article 3(1) of and Schedule 2 to the Northern Ireland (Modification of Enactments — No. 1) Order 1973(b) and with the concurrence of the Treasury(c), hereby makes the following Regulations:—

- 1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Judicial Pensions (Northern Ireland) (Widows' and Children's Benefits) (Amendment) Regulations 1987 and shall come into operation on 1st April 1987.
- (2) The Interpretation Act 1978(d) shall apply to the interpretation of these Regulations as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 2. Regulation 15 of the Judicial Pensions (Northern Ireland) (Widows' and Children's Benefits) Regulations 1987(e) shall be amended as follows—
  - (a) by deleting, at paragraph (1), the words "Schedule 2" and substituting the words "Schedule 1";
  - (b) by deleting, at paragraph (2), the words "Schedule 3" and substituting the words "Schedule 2".

## **EXPLANATORY NOTE**
