**The Income Support (General) (Amendment No. 4)
Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1991**

Made 2nd August 1991.

Coming into operation 12th August 1991

The Department of Health and Social Services, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 23(1) of the Social Security (Northern Ireland) Order 1986(a) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations:

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Income Support (General) (Amendment No. 4) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1991 and shall come into operation on 12th August 1991.

(2) In these regulations “the principal regulations” means the Income Support (General) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1987(b).

Amendment of regulation 21 of the principal regulations

2. In regulation 21 of the principal regulations (special cases)—

(a) in paragraph (3), in the definition of “residential accommodation” for “paragraph (4)” there shall be substituted “paragraphs (3A) and (4)”;

(b) after paragraph (3) there shall be inserted the following paragraph—

“(3A) Where on or after 12th August 1991 a person is in, or only temporarily absent from, residential accommodation within the meaning of paragraph (3) and that accommodation subsequently becomes a home for persons in need within the meaning of regulation 19(2) (persons in homes for persons in need and nursing homes) that person shall continue to be treated as being in residential accommodation if, and for so long as, he remains in the same accommodation and the Department is under a duty to provide or make arrangements for providing accommodation for that person.”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations.)

These regulations further amend the Income Support (General) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1987 by providing that, on or after 12th August 1991, where a person is in or only temporarily absent from residential accommodation provided or arranged by the Department of Health and Social Services, he shall continue to be treated as being in the same residential accommodation for the purposes of determining his applicable amount notwithstanding the fact that the home is or becomes a home for persons in need.

The regulations correspond to provision contained in regulations made by the Secretary of State for Social Security in relation to Great Britain and accordingly, by virtue of section 10(2) of, and paragraph 21 of Schedule 3 to, the Social Security Act 1980 (c. 30), are not subject to the requirement of section 10(1) of that Act for prior reference to the Social Security Advisory Committee.
