AND WHEREAS no objection or representation has been received:

NOW THEREFORE the Department, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 21(1) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order 1981 and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Urban Clearways (Belfast) (No. 2) Order (Amendment No. 3) Order (Northern Ireland) 1995 and shall come into operation on 27th November 1995.

Amendment

2. The Schedule to the Urban Clearways (Belfast) (No. 2) Order (Northern Ireland) 1981(b) shall be amended by—

- (a) the deletion of the items relating to Castle Place, Donegall Place and High Street;
- (b) the substitution for the item relating to Castle Street of the following items:----

(a) S.I. 1981/154 (N.I. 1); see Article 2(2) for the definition of "Department"
(b) S.R. 1981 No. 304; relevant amending rules are S.R. 1985 No. 246 and S.R. 1987 No. 371

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order.)

This Order further amends the Urban Clearways (Belfast) (No. 2) Order (Northern Ireland) 1981 by removing the prohibition of waiting by vehicles during the morning and evening peak traffic periods from Monday to Friday inclusive in Castle Place, Castle Street (from King Street to Castle Place), Donegall Place and High Street (from the prolongation of the east kerbline of Bridge Street to Cornmarket), Belfast.
