## SCHEDULE 7

Specified Requirements for Practical or Unitary Test

## Part 5

Unitary Test: Categories F, G, H and K

- (1) Read in good daylight (with the aid of corrective lenses if worm) a registration mark fixed to a motor vehicle and containing letters and figures 79.4 millimetres high at a distance of—
  - (a) 12.3 metres, in the case of a unitary test conducted in respect of a vehicle included in category K;
  - (b) 20.5 metres in any other case.
  - (2) Start the engine of the vehicle.
  - (3) Move away straight ahead or at an angle.
  - (4) Overtake, meet or cross the path of other vehicles and take an appropriate course.
  - (5) Turn right-hand and left-hand corners correctly.
- (6) Stop the vehicle in an emergency and normally and, in the latter case, bring it to rest in an appropriate part of the road.
  - (7) In the case of category F and K, be fully conversant with the contents of the Highway Code.
