# The County Court Fees (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 1998

Made - - - - 18th November 1998
Coming into operation 1st December 1998

The Lord Chancellor, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 116(1) of the Judicature (Northern Ireland) Act 1978(1), after consultation with the Lord Chief Justice and with the concurrence of the Treasury, hereby makes the following Order:—

#### Citation and commencement

**1.** This order may be cited as the County Court Fees (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 1998 and shall come into operation on 1st December 1998.

#### Fees to be taken in proceedings in county courts

**2.** For Schedule 1 to the County Court Fees Order (Northern Ireland) 1996(**2**) there shall be substituted the new Schedule 1 set out in the Schedule to this Order.
