# Building Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2000

## PART R

Access and facilities for disabled people

## Sanitary accommodation and sanitary conveniences

- **R3.**—(1) If sanitary accommodation is provided in a building, other than in a dwelling or in a shop which has a floor area of less than  $50 \text{ m}^2$ , that accommodation shall include reasonable provision for disabled people.
  - (2) In a dwelling a sanitary convenience shall be provided—
    - (a) in the entrance storey; or
    - (b) where the entrance storey contains no habitable rooms in the principal storey.
