The Department of the Environment, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Articles 55(1) and (2) and 110(2) of the Road Traffic (Northern Ireland) Order $1995(\mathbf{a})$ and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations shall be cited as the Road Vehicles Lighting (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2003 and shall come into operation on 25th February 2003.

Amendment to Schedule 19

2. In Part III of Schedule 19 to the Road Vehicles Lighting Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2000(**b**) for diagrams 1 to 5 there shall be substituted the diagrams set out in the Schedule.


