**The Health and Social Services Trusts (Exercise of
Functions) (Amendment) Regulations
(Northern Ireland) 2003**

Made - - - - - *27th March 2003*

Coming into operation *31st March 2003*

The Department of Health, Social Services and Public Safety, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 3(2) of the Health and Personal Social Services (Northern Ireland) Order 1994(a) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Health and Social Services Trusts (Exercise of Functions) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2003 and shall come into operation on 31st March 2003.

Amendment of the Health and Social Services Trusts (Exercise of Functions) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1994

2. The Schedule to the Health and Social Services Trusts (Exercise of Functions) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1994(b) shall be amended as follows –

- (a) in the first column (Statutory Provision) there shall be inserted at the end the words “Carers and Direct Payments Act (Northern Ireland) 2002(c)”; and
- (b) in the second column (Relevant Functions of a Health and Social Services Board) there shall be added at the end the words “All Functions”.
