Article 112B(7)	For paragraph (7), substitute –
	"(7) In this Article – "adopter", in relation to a child, means a person by whom the child has been or is to be adopted or, in a case where the child has been or is to be adopted by two people jointly, whichever of them is the child's adopter for the purposes of regulations under this Article; "adoption from overseas" means the adoption of a child who enters Northern Ireland from outside the United Kingdom in connection with or for the purposes of adoption which does not involve the placement of the child for adoption
