The Department of Enterprise, Trade and Investment, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 1(3) of the Insolvency (Northern Ireland) Order 2002<sup>(1)</sup> and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order –

**Citation**

1. This Order may be cited as the Insolvency (2002 Order) (Commencement) Order (Northern Ireland) 2003.

**Appointed day**

2. Subject to Articles 2 to 7 of the Insolvency (2002 Order) (Transitional Provisions) Order (Northern Ireland) 2003<sup>(2)</sup>, the day appointed for the coming into operation of the Insolvency (Northern Ireland) Order 2002, in so far as it is not already in operation, is 2nd February 2004.
