The Marketing and Use of Dangerous Substances (No. 4) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2003

Prohibition on the placing on the market of short chain chlorinated paraffins

4. A person shall not place short chain chlorinated paraffins (alkanes, C_{10} – C_{13}) on the market for use as substances, or as constituents of other substances or preparations in concentrations higher than 1% either in metalworking or for fat liquoring of leather.
