
STATUTORY RULES OF NORTHERN IRELAND

**The Justice (Northern Ireland) Act
2004 (Commencement) Order 2004**

2.—(1) The following provisions of the Justice (Northern Ireland) Act 2004 shall come into operation on 14th July 2004.

(2) The provisions referred to in paragraph (1) above are –

Section 9 (the Juvenile Justice Board);

Section 11 (bail under section 67 of the Terrorism Act 2000), together with Schedule 2 (bail under Terrorism Act 2000);

Section 12 (bail to which Part II of the Criminal Justice (Northern Ireland) Order 2003 applies);

Section 13 (transfer of prisoners);

Section 14 (amendment of section 103 of the Terrorism Act 2000);

Section 15 (arrest without warrant for offence of driving while disqualified);

Section 17 (right of barrister to enter into contract for the provision of his services);

Section 18 (repeals) to the extent necessary to bring into force the provisions of Schedule 4 (repeals) specified below; and

in Schedule 4, the entry in respect of the Prisons Act (Northern Ireland) 1953⁽¹⁾, the entry in respect of the Malone and Whiteabbey Training Schools Act (Northern Ireland) 1956⁽²⁾, the entry in respect of the Criminal Justice (Children) (Northern Ireland) Order 1998⁽³⁾, in the entry in respect of the Justice (Northern Ireland) Act 2002⁽⁴⁾, the repeal of the words “(other than the Juvenile Justice Board)” in section 46(1)(h), the entry in respect of the Commissioner for Children and Young People (Northern Ireland) Order 2003⁽⁵⁾ and the entry in respect of the Criminal Justice (Northern Ireland) Order 2003⁽⁶⁾.
