Salaries (Comptroller and Auditor General) (No. 2) Order (Northern Ireland) 2005

Made - - - - 3rd November 2005

Coming into operation 30th December 2005

To be laid before Parliament under paragraph 7(3) of the Schedule to the Northern Ireland Act 2000

In exercise of the powers conferred by Article 4(1) of the Audit (Northern Ireland) Order 1987(**a**) and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby make the following Order:

Title and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Salaries (Comptroller and Auditor General) (No. 2) Order (Northern Ireland) 2005 and shall come into operation on 30th December 2005.

Revocation

2. The Salaries (Comptroller and Auditor General) Order (Northern Ireland) 2005(**b**) is hereby revoked.

Salary

3. The annual salary payable to the holder of the office of Comptroller and Auditor General shall be increased from $\pounds 122,435$ to $\pounds 126,108$ with effect from 1st April 2005.
